Suffering

The Problem Of Evil Evil = bad things

- 1. God, if he is exists, is all loving, all knowing and all powerful
- 2. God, if he is all loving, would not tolerate evil
- 3. God, if he is all knowing, would know how to stop evil
- 4. God, if he is all powerful, would have the power to stop evil
- 5. Evil exists
- 6. Therefore, God does not

Solutions

- God achieves good things through bad
 - God works on a different time scale
 - God is love... free will

- 1. It was impossible for God to create us all loving, all powerful and all knowing (or we would be GOD!)
 - 2. The most loving way God could create us is to have free will
 - 3. People who are not all loving may misuse free will causing evil
- 4. Therefore, despite the existence of evil, God may exist

Evil

- God did not create it
- Evil freely chosen over good
 - Evil an absence of good
 - Breakdown in creation

Why Suffering?

- Sometimes God accomplishes good things through it
 - Joseph
